The award explains what a Carbon Footprint is and then teaches young people how they can take positive action to reduce their own, their families and their schools Carbon Footprint. It is a skill based course that trains them with practical techniques such as:

- How to produce a home energy conservation plan

- Where their local recycling points are
- Where to buy local sustainable foods in order to reduce food miles
- How to produce a green travel plan for themselves and their families
